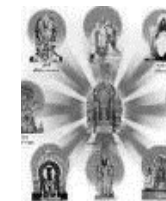
Mahalakshmi Homa is performed to receive the blessings of Goddess Lakshmi, the Goddess of wealth, to achieve prosperity in this material world.

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF PARVATI KALYAN MANTRA AND HOMA

Goddess Parvati, daughter of Himavan and Maneka, performed severe austerities on the bank of Manasarovar, at the foot of Mount Kailash, standing on one leg and surviving on dry leaves, to get Lord Shiva as her husband. The desolate landscape, long dark winters, and the bone chilling blizzards did not break her will and determination. Finally pleased with her devotion and sacrifice, the Lord of ascetics, Neelakantha Mahadeva accepted Parvati as His consort. During her severe penance, Parvati chanted this kalyana mantra to propitiate the meditating Lord Shiva. Parvati accumulated much merit (punya), power (shakti), and purity (shuddhi) as a result of her penance. Devotees who chant the Parvati Kalyan mantra and participate in the kalyan mahotsava puja can, without undergoing any such penance, freely draw from this merit deposit receiving blessings of Shiva and Parvati for the benefit of getting suitable spouses and also for the boon of a long happy married life.
