Directions to the Sambodh Center for Human Excellence

From Grand Rapids: Take US 131 South to Exit 44; make a left onto "D" Ave and drive 6 miles where it turns South becoming Sprinkle Rd; Turn <u>right</u> on "G" Avenue; in ½ mile turn right onto 24th Street (See General Instructions below).

From Detroit: Take I-94 west to Exit 80 in Kalamazoo; Take Sprinkle Rd north about 6 miles, turn <u>left</u> at "G" Avenue intersection light; in ½ mile turn <u>right</u> onto 24th Street (See General Instructions below).

From Chicago: Take I-94 east to Exit 80 in Kalamazoo; Take Sprinkle Rd north about 6 miles, turn <u>left</u> at "G" Avenue intersection light; in ½ mile turn <u>right</u> onto 24th Street AND. **General Instructions:** Drive approx 1.5 miles north; On your left, see the green Sambodh mailbox and colorful SCHE sign, and turn up the boulderlined driveway.




