

**About the Facility for the  
Bodhananda Vedic Institute

Constructed in 2007, The Sambodh Society, Inc. facility is comprised of two levels, each nearly 1500 square feet, nestled into the hillside of a 32-acre woodland glacial moraine setting just 10 minute from downtown Kalamazoo and 15 minutes from the Kalamazoo-Battle Creek International Airport.



The Sambodh headquarters facility in Kalamazoo, MI, which has been given the name, Sambodh Center for Human Excellence, hosts the School of Ayurveda. The walkout lower level is utilized for our Ayurvedic classes:



Full weekend classes are held throughout the year. Completion of our one-year course of study in Ayurveda fulfills a portion of the requirements for professional practitioner membership in the National Ayurvedic Medical Association (NAMA). Those who successfully complete the requirements for the full course of study will receive certification as an Ayurvedic Consultant.

The Lower Walk-out Level of the Sambodh Center facility is the primary classroom space utilized for the Bodhananda Vedic Institute, School of Ayurveda Program weekend class session.
